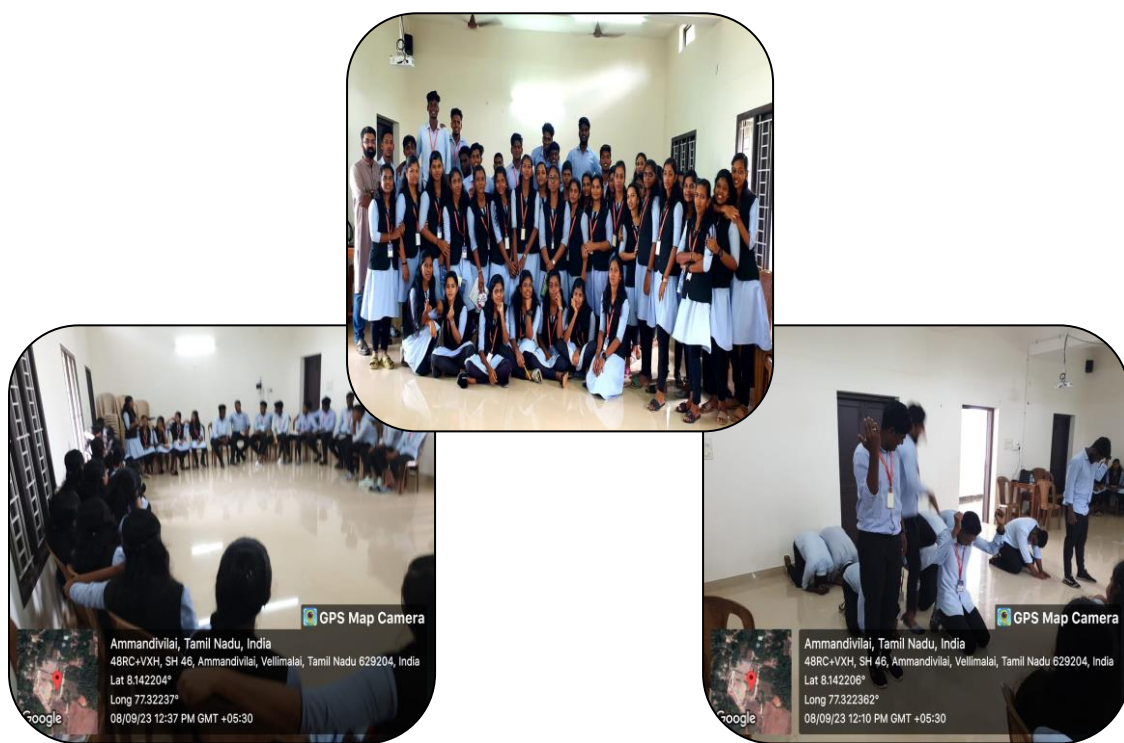
To make the students realize the importance of Decision making, Team work, Coordination and Communication.



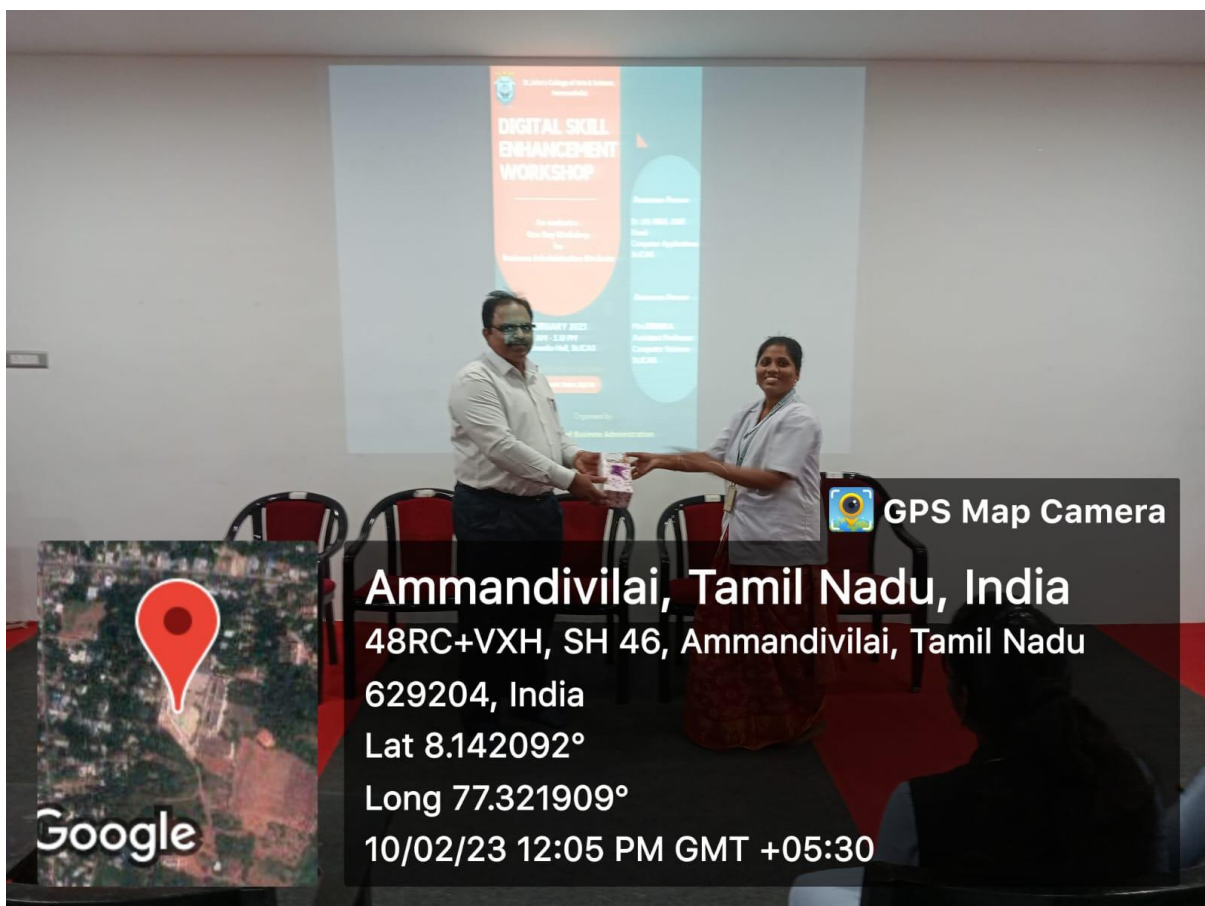

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
