REGULATIONS

DRESS CODE

BOYS

GIRLS

 Use only traditional Churidhar/Salwar-Kameez with sleeves and avoid deep neckline. Slit in the Churidhar should not be more than 10 inches above the knee level. Wearing of shawl/dupatta is a must.

Short Salwars, Cholis, Jeans, Shorts, Mini-Skirts and T-Shirts are not allowed at any time.

Students are not allowed to bleach their hair.

Note: All students are instructed to adhere strictly to the Dress Code.

Students must note that violation of the regulations stated above will entail severe punishment.

Possessing and using Cell Phones and other Electronic items like Cameras, Walkmans and Radios are strictly prohibited in the College.

Ragging is Strictly Prohibited Inside and Outside the Campus

Ragging is a crime in the eyes of Law. It is a cognizable offence. The Government of Tamil Nadu has banned ragging in educational institutions vide its order No.7 dated 14/12/1997 which makes ragging punishable as follows: Imprisonment upto a term of two years, a fine upto Rs. 10,000/- and dismissal from the institution. The student so dismissed shall not be admitted to any other educational institution. Students are warned not to commit any act that could be construed as ragging. They are also exhorted to rise up against this evil.
