
# FRESHERS DAY

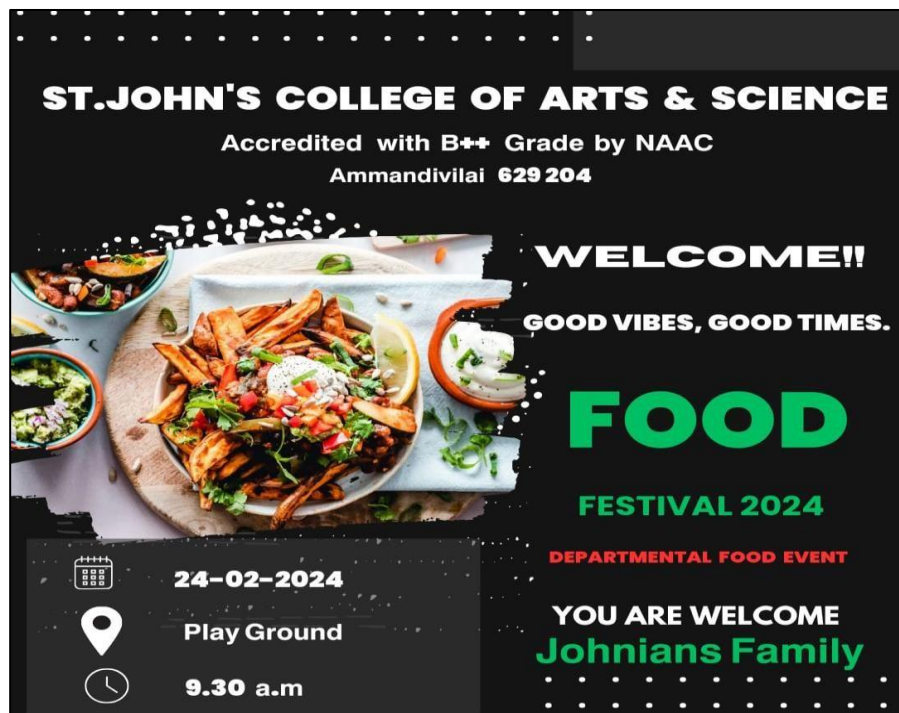
## Sports day
