- To teach our staff members, students, and partners how to plant trees annually.

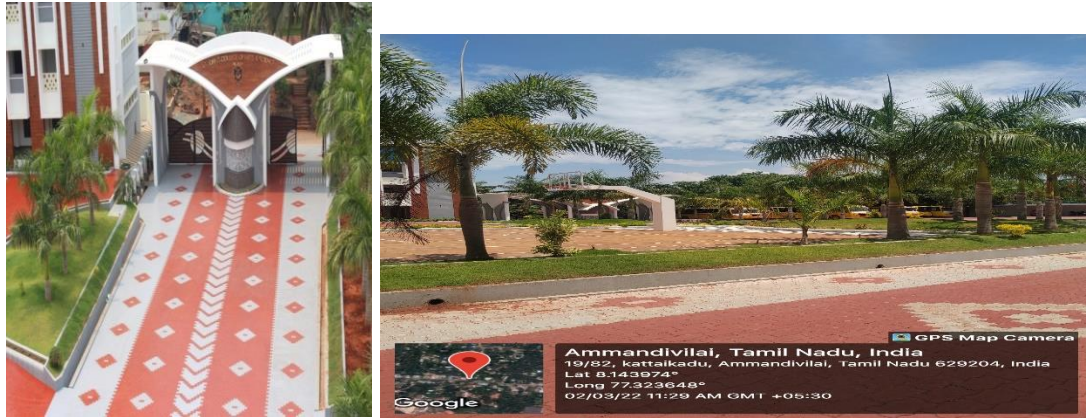
Students and staff will be informed of this policy through internal channels of communication. The Principal will conduct frequent reviews of the Environment, Energy Policies and Goals.
