



Mentor Evaluation Report

- The students were met by their mentors once in a month in order to take a look at their difficulties in learning.
- The mentor had a counseling session with their mentees during 3 to 4 P.m.
- During the session mentors will find their issues which they are dealing with and would find ways to solve their issues.
- The major problem met by the mentees are medium of instruction in English. Since all the students were from Tamil Medium they find it difficult to pick up
- Finally remedial measures were taken in such a way that difficult words should be explained in Tamil so that they can understand the concepts very quickly
- The mentees are encouraged by their mentors to talk in English. It will make them to be familiar with the concepts
- A student who was teased by some boys nearby her neighborhood was suffering from depression and fear. She was not able to face them and was helped by the mentors
- Their progress in weekly exam has been noted.
- The mentees are encouraged by their mentors for their change of attitude
- By pinpointing out certain real facts that is happening in and around us were explained by the mentor to the mentees, and their dress code, behaviour in public places, respect to the elders were also explained
- Mentees were taught about the cleanliness, how they should keep their homes, places around him. in the public places, in the class room, in the college campus and nearby their residential area. If the surroundings are clean they will be free from their diseases like Malaria. Typhoid and other viral diseases
- A student who had lost his father was not able to pursue his studies as he was not able to meet the financial expenses of his studies was counseled and helped by the college management to meet his financial expenses.
- A student who was caught in a love affair was counseled and made her to realize that her career is more important than these crushes.
- A student who was very conscious about her appearance was made to realize that appearances are deceptive and her manners and qualities mean the most for everyone

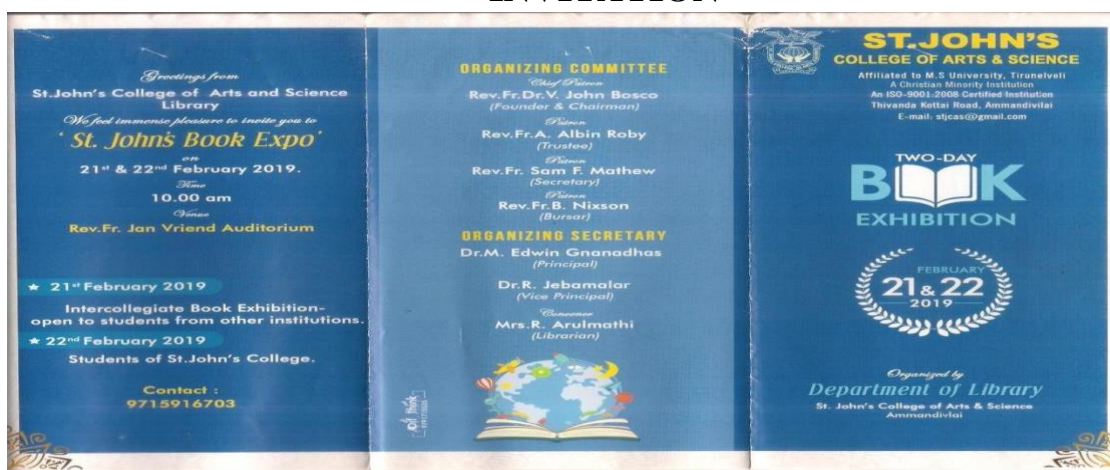


Intercollegiate Book Exhibition & Book Donation Day 1st, 2nd & 3rd March 2018

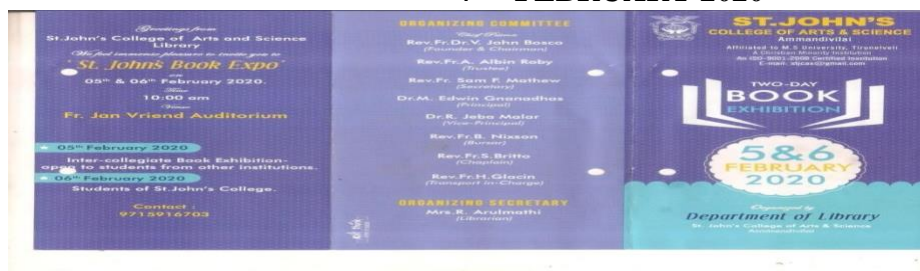
