


Program Objective:

To encourage students to take entrepreneurship as a career and to give awareness about the Government Schemes available for the development and support of Young Entrepreneurs.



Dr.F. Eframe Sophia Selvam, Head of the Department of commerce has given a small introduction about social entrepreneurship. Dr.S.David, the Co-ordinator Entrepreneurship cell, welcome the conference participators. Next Dr.R. Rathiha felicitated the gathering. Dr. R.Raisha Pravin Joy introduced the Chief Guest Ms. Anar Metha, Founder president, Srishti Bharat Foundation. Ms. Anar Metha addressed the gathering, In her talk she explained the growth and importance of the social entrepreneurship. Next Mr. Ramachandra, the key note speaker gave his key note address. ABSTRACT

Graph theory is one of the most important fields in mathematics used in structural models. Graph theory was introduced by the great swiss mathematician Leonard Euler during the 18th century to solve many mathematical problems by constructing graphs based on given data or a set of points. In a short time period graph theory developed to a large degree and became a source of interest to many researchers. Graph theory and its topology developed by using the modern algebra techniques. The use of these techniques comes from the work of the physicist Gustav Kirchhoff for his Kirchhoff's circuit laws for calculating the voltage and current in electric circuits which was published in 1845. Graph theory in mathematics helps to study the graphs which can be the mathematical structures used to build pairwise relations between objects. Graph is made up of vertices connected by edges. A distinction is made between undirected graphs, where edges link two vertices symmetrically, and directed graphs, where edges link two vertices asymmetrically. 




